Dear CIRP colleagues,

On behalf of the German CIRP delegation, we have the honour to invite you to the 70th CIRP General Assembly (GA) from 22nd to 29th August 2021. This conference will take place in virtual form due to the ongoing corona situation.

The 70th CIRP GA promises to be an intellectually stimulating event with world-renowned scientists presenting the latest advances in production technology. As the conference takes place in virtual form, new formats have been developed to enable a diverse exchange between the participants to discuss new ideas, strengthen existing relationships and establish new collaborations with leading researchers and industrial companies. In the following, we would like to draw your attention to some points concerning CIRP GA 2021.

Registration

We are pleased to announce that registration for the 70th CIRP GA is now possible. Please click on our [“How to register“](#) and register until 31 May (CEST) to take advantage of the early bird rate. We recommend that you complete your registration by the end of July 2021 so that your registration information is included in the list of the participants. This year, only payment by credit card is possible due to the administrative work involved for bank transfer payments.

For participating in the CIRP General Assembly, you usually have the choice between three participation categories (Part I only, Part II only, or Part I+II). This year, we can offer you a single price for the entire conference duration due to the digital conference format, for which the cost structure hardly scales with the duration of your participation. For you, as a CIRP Member or Research Affiliate, this means that we are offering one attractive price that allows you to partake in the entire conference. This includes all sessions from 22 to 29 August 2021, the opening session and the closing ceremony, the programme, and also gives access to the lists of the participants and exhibitors. Attendance to all further features integrated in the conference platform, such as the virtual exhibition, is guaranteed. Guests can participate as specified by the CIRP Member in the ‘Request Form for a Guest’.

Programme

As usual, the conference programme is available on the website. A download with a complete overview of the 70th CIRP GA programme and further information will be available within the next weeks. A daily time slot was chosen from 12:00 pm to 5:30 pm CEST for all live sessions, taking time zone differences into consideration, to enable international attendees to participate in the conference actively.

Part I - Paper sessions will be held from 23 to 25 August 2021.

Pre-recordings of the presentations will be requested until 1 August. The pre-recorded lectures will be released for viewing in advance. The authors will then give a 5-minute short live presentation in the conference time slot, followed by a 15-minute moderated discussion session.

Part II - Group meetings (STC, CWG, etc.) will be from 26 to 29 August 2021.

On Sunday, 22 August, we would like to invite you to the conference platform's virtual Opening Ceremony. Afterwards, the keynote papers will be presented before concluding the day with the presentation of the CIRP GA 2022.

The Board Meeting and the Membership Committees Meeting will already take place in virtual form on Saturday, 21 August. The members that are affected by these meetings will be contacted directly.
